1-7E-2: PROTECTION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS:

It shall be unlawful for any person to displace, remove, injure or in any way interfere with, or place obstructions upon any survey stake or monument marked as such, in any public street, alley, avenue or sidewalk, and any person violating any provision of this section shall be guilty of a class C misdemeanor and subject to penalty as provided in section <u>1-4-1</u> of this code.
