

Chapter 8 ELECTIONS

1-8-1: PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY:

- A. Purpose: Pursuant to powers granted by the state, as set forth in various provisions of Utah Code Annotated, the city intends by this chapter to govern and regulate the procedures of election of officers. (1995 Code § 21-1-1)
- B. Authority: The city council shall have the authority, powers and duty to enforce these provisions. The city council shall have the authority to interpolate, amend, delete or change any or all of this chapter at any regular scheduled or special meeting called for that purpose, being that a quorum is present and a majority vote so dictates. (1995 Code § 21-1-2)

1-8-2: ELECTION CODE ADOPTED:

The election code of the state (Utah Code Annotated title 20A) is enacted and adopted by reference for use in the city, and any amendments that shall be made by the state from time to time shall also be enacted and adopted by reference hereto. (1995 Code § 21-2-1; amd. 2003 Code)
