

3-6-1: DEFINITIONS:

In addition to the definitions set forth in section 3-1-3 of this title, the following phrase as used in this chapter shall have the meaning herein prescribed:

ITINERANT OR TRANSIENT MERCHANT: Any person who offers for sale at wholesale or retail any goods, wares or merchandise in or from any hotel, stall, tent, building, structure, stand, railroad car, motor vehicle, field, corner, or other place in the city, and who shall not occupy said place for the purpose of conducting a permanent business thereon or therein, shall be deemed an itinerant or transient merchant.
