

13-3-21: RECOVERY OF SERVICE EXTENSION COSTS, WHEN:

No person in the grantee's service area shall be arbitrarily refused service; but in recognition of the capital cost involved in unusual circumstances, including, without limitation, instances when the distance from distribution cable to connection of service to subscribers is more than forty five (45) meters (150 cable feet) or when a subscriber density exists less than the density specified hereinabove, service may be made available on the basis of costs of materials, labor and easements, in order to prevent inequitable burdens on cable subscribers in more densely populated areas.
